Students wishing to earn a letter must achieve certain requirements in order to be considered to receive that high honor. In addition, students must show a high level of commitment to Castle View Theatre Company, which includes going above and beyond what is expected.

To obtain a letter, you must have a total of **20 thespian points** including **5 full points backstage (50 hours)**. All backstage hours *have to be documented* from productions this year. It is your responsibility to add your points using the official High School Thespian Point System created by the International Thespian Society (<https://www.schooltheatre.org/internationalthespiansociety/troupedirectors/thespianpointssystem>). We will only consider points from the current school year – Fall 2018 through Spring 2019.

All lettering points must be achieved and turned in by Thursday, April 18th. Mr. Scott and Mrs. Walter will make all final lettering decisions.

*If you are part of a theatre production (e.g. Production Ensemble class) that performs after the due date, you must confirm with the theatre directors to earn points for these.

In order to letter in Theatre at Castle View High School, the following requirements must be met:

- Full participation in at least 1 of the major stage performances this school year (fall musical or spring play)
- Positive attitude & leadership
- 20 Thespian points* (which include 5 tech points – 50 hours)
*you do *not* need to be thespian to earn a letter
- 5 of your points (= 50 work hours backstage) *must* come from backstage work
- Attend meetings and theatre events
- Brief essay (100-150 words) as to why you should letter
